**USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROJECT:**

**WHO?**

24 boys and girls, 15 / 25 years old, coming from Greece, France, Slovenia and Italy.

**WHAT?**

8 intercultural days for thinking about European citizenship, rights, stereotypes and Roma minorities.

**WHEN?**

From the 3rd to 11th of July 2014.

**WHERE?**

Rome, Italy - in “La città dell’Utopia” (<http://www.lacittadellutopia.it/>)

The accommodation will be in shared rooms with shared bathroom. Please, be aware of this and put in your backpack a bit of patience, ability to adapt and flexibility!



### **WHAT TO BRING?**

### **WHAT WILL WE DO?**

Theater workshops, games, visits to the city, role playing, parties, fun activities, intercultural evenings, a final event and much more!

### **HOW MUCH?**

All the activities, meals and accommodation are funded by the European Commission.

The 70% of the travel costs is covered by the project.

From Slovenia: maximum 300 euro per person.

From Greece: maximum 400 euro per person.

From France: maximum 400 euro per person.

From other Italian cities to Rome: 200 euro per person

Youth leader gets all travel costs covered.

### **LANGUAGE**

The language of the camp is English.

### **Brief description of the activities:**

The youth exchange "Playing for rights" will gather together 24 participants, coming from Italy, France, Greece and Slovenia, who will be hosted for 9 days in Rome, at the "Utopia City" - a social and cultural laboratory working for a new model of local and global development: balanced, sustainable and fair.

In the 20th anniversary of the European citizenship, the general aim of the project is double: raising awareness among the participants on the rights stemming from it, focusing, especially on the condition of the Roma minorities across Europe; encouraging the young participants to play an active role toward the construction of an inclusive European society and strengthening mutual understanding among European citizens.

The activities will mix together theatrical and artistic workshops, role-playing, non formal education laboratories on the topics of the exchange and leisure time.

The final outcome of the project will be a theatre performance and the local community will be invited over.
