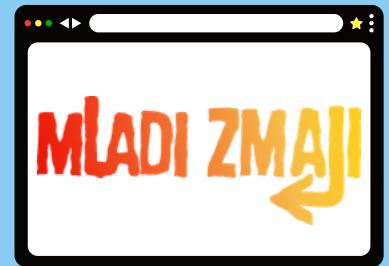


ABOUT THE PROJECT

Youth centres are like a public living room where young people can get information, make friends, gain self-confidence and learn social skills.

Programmes include opportunities for non-formal and informal learning and everyday socialising, where visitors can gain new knowledge and skills, meet interesting people, broaden their horizons, get motivation and overcome their own limitations.
