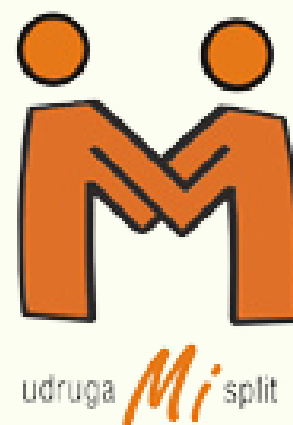
Association “MI” – Split is a non-profit organization founded in **1996** in Split, Croatia.

Who can apply?

If you are 18–30 years old and come from a country covered by the European Solidarity Corps programme, you can join our volunteering journey in Split!

When?

October 2026 – June 2027

A 8-month volunteering experience in Croatia

Volunteering schedule

You will participate in volunteering activities for up to 6 hours per day, mainly from Monday to Friday. Some activities and events may occasionally take place outside regular working hours.

Holiday time

You will have the right to annual leave during your volunteering period.

Holiday dates are planned together with your coordinator to ensure a good balance between your volunteering activities and personal time.

 Please note: our organisation usually has a collective break during Christmas and New Year holidays.

Golden Age Centre – volunteering with seniors

One of your main activities will be supporting our Golden Age Centre, a place where older adults meet, learn, socialize, and enjoy different activities.

You will:

- support participants during workshops
- help organize activities
- bring your own ideas and interests
